attract	To pull toward or pull together.	Magnets Interacting with Materials
design	A plan for a new device or tool.	Designing Magnetic Devices
device	A tool made for a particular purpose.	Designing Magnetic Devices
engineer	Someone who designs things to meet needs and solve problems.	Designing Magnetic Devices
magnet	An object that pulls on iron and some other materials, and either pushes or pulls on other magnets.	Magnets Interacting with Materials
magnetic	Something that is attracted (or pulled) to a magnet.	Magnets Interacting with Materials
non-magnetic	Something that is not attracted (or pulled) to a magnet.	Magnets Interacting with Materials
prototype	The first version of a device built from a design. Often used to test the design to learn if it works as expected.	Building Magnetic Devices
repel	To push away.	Testing Magnets on Magnets
technology	Things people make to meet needs and solve problems.	Designing Magnetic Devices
